18 TO ALL PARTIES AND TO THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

19 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on 5/20/99 at 3:00 p.m. in Department of the  
20 above-entitled court located at 325 S. Melrose , Vista, CA that Plaintiff and  
21 Judgment Creditor Steven Casper ("judgment creditor") will move this court for an  
22 order instructing judgment debtor DAVID E. DAVISON to assign his interest in the  
23 military reserve pay he receives as lieutenant commander in the U.S. Naval  
24 Reserves and all rights to payment thereunder to the judgment creditor to the  
25 extent necessary to pay the judgment creditor's judgment in full including  
26 accrued interest through the date of final payment. The balance of the judgment

1 with accrued interest to 5/20/99, the date of the hearing, is \$36,940.93. The  
2 judgment creditor seeks an order directing the obligor, the U.S. Naval Reserves,  
3 to make all payments pursuant to this assignment order directly to the judgment  
4 creditor's attorney, Mark Krones, until the judgment with accrued interest is  
5 paid in full. The judgment creditor also seeks an order restraining DAVID E.  
6 DAVISON from encumbering or assigning his rights to these payments. This motion  
7 is made on the grounds that the judgment in this case is unsatisfied, that the  
8 judgment creditor is entitled to have these payments assigned to him and that  
9 there is a need to restrain the judgment debtor from encumbering or assigning his  
rights to military reserve payments.

10 This motion will be decided on the date set forth, but there will be no  
11 hearing in open court. After 3:00 p.m. on the hearing date, parties may obtain  
12 the ruling by telephoning (760) 806.6050, which was the number provided by the  
13 court clerk when the reservation for the motion was obtained. Requests for oral  
14 argument must be made in accordance with rule 6.18. The court may in its  
15 discretion require oral argument and shall so indicate in the telephonic ruling.

16 This motion to compel will be based on this Notice, the attached Memorandum  
17 of Points and Authorities, the declarations of David Jansen and Mark P. Krones,  
18 and other pleadings filed herein, or any other matter that the Court may properly  
19 take notice, and

21 such further oral and documentary evidence as may be presented at the time of the  
22 hearing.
